

Little bags with special shapes

Workshop with Judit Pócs

On this workshop we will make special formed little purses with special closers.

We can incorporate different materials into the surface, such as sequenced fabric, silk-metal organza, sari pieces, beads...etc...

You can create purses for your glasses, pencils, or any small items.

What we need:

- Pens and paper to design
- IKEA mat Variera (with dots) we can halve them, that's enough for one person
- 2 mm thick styrofoam (isolating plastic) for the template
- Bubble wrap for some smaller templates
- Waterresist pencils
- Sharpe little and bigger scissors (also nailscissors, which cut a bit round)
- Hand soap for each person (baby soap with lanoline for example)
- Bowl for water for each
- Towels for each person
- 1 piece of Net to secure the fibres from moving while rubbing (around 50 x 40 cm per piece)
- A piece of cotton textile (an old piece of sheet) to roll (around 40 x 60 cm)
- Synthetic kitchen clothe to absorbe the water (one for each)
- Tape measure
- Fine Australian merino wool (18-19 Micron) in rowings, around 200 g

What people might bring, but it's not an obligation just possibilities:

- If you like you can also take wool yarns for decoration
- Silk and different sort of textile pieces, sequenced fabric, sari pieces
- Glass or metal beads, in case you would like to decorate your purse with it. The beads should be around 5 mm diameter, and the hole should be around 2 mm diameter, not smaller than that.
- Little buttons for the closer, but it's also possible to sew them on afterwards
