Materialliste

- white Merino wool 18-16 mic, white silk (habotai/pongee or excelsior).
- unwoven tissues (there should be enough to completely cover your item on both sides).
- 2-3 plastic bowls for soaking tissues (cut plastic bottles of 5-6 liters from water are very suitable)
- a couple of smaller containers to prepare dyes
- pipe (to roll the work around it, the pipe should fit the pot)
- rope (must be strong and long enough to wrap tightly around our roll)
- roll of food stretching film
- soap
- a couple of towels
- gloves to protect hands from dyes
- 200-300 grams of table vinegar.
- bubble wrap, threads and a needle, waterproof felt-tip pens, pins, a calculator, a sewing tape, scissors
- fresh or dried leaves of maple, mountain ash, linden, walnut, oak, peony, fern, mulberry and any other leaves of a beautiful shape and similar density are suitable. There should be enough leaves to spread evenly on the surface of your product. Fresh leaves can give a brighter print.
